- 1. What was your first experience of being infatuated? How did it feel? How did it turn out?
- 2. We are told to "follow God's example" (Ephesians 5:1). Why is it possible for me to follow the One who is infinitely greater than me?
- 3. We are to follow God's example "as dearly loved children" (Ephesians 5:1). How do children follow an example, in ways that are different from how adults follow? So then, how do I follow God's example as a dearly loved child?
- 4. We are also told to "live a life of love, just as Christ loved us" (v2). List a few examples of Christ being loving. Then, analyse why those actions can be classified as loving.
- 5. The ultimate expression of love was Jesus taking our sins on the cross. Explain, in terms that a non-Christian could understand, why the cross is an expression of love.
- 6. I am told to "live a life of love, just as Christ loved" (Ephesians 5:2). Imagine a friend was telling you how to do just that. What would this friend say to you?
