## For personal reflection or group discussion

- 1. Have you ever prayed earnestly for something, but it didn't happen, and you were left wondering what God was doing? On reflection, do you now know why things turned out differently than you had hoped?
- 2. If you were to help God make some changes, what are the top 3 issues you would tell Him to address?
- 3. Abraham was pretty generous with the feast he prepared (v.6-7). In what ways can I be generous to God?
- 4. Why did Sarah laugh (v12)? God already knew the answer, so why did He ask why she laughed (v14)? What question do you think God would like to ask you?
- 5. What did Sarah feel (v15)? Why did she feel that way? What were the consequences of that feeling? In what circumstance might it be right to feel that way before God? How does the Gospel help overcome that feeling?
- 6. What words describe Abraham's attitude in v22-33? When Abraham went back home and told Sarah about the 'conversation' he had with God, how do you think he may have felt? In what ways would that debrief have helped Sarah's faith? In what ways does it help my faith?
