Discussion Starters:

1. What are 3 words that a friend would use to describe your appearance, and 3 words to describe your personality? Do you think you, or the friend who described you, has a more accurate estimation of you? What do you need to do in order to accurately describe someone?
2. What do you need to do in order to accurately describe God? What are the attributes of God's character that you most appreciate? What do you think God finds most appealing in you?
3. Adam was placed in the Garden of Eden to do work (2:15). Why do you think God incorporated work in a perfect world? How can we work in a way that honours God? (Eph.4:28, Col.3:22-24)
4. What can you know of God's character from Gen.2:16? Give another example of Him showing that same quality. Is that characteristic in 2:16 contradicted in 2:17? Give another example of Him showing that same quality He displayed in 2:17. How can I display the qualities displayed in both 2:16 and 2:17?
5. What do you think are the strongest arguments for, and against, gay marriage? Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. In v9-10 why do you think so many different sins are lumped together? There is always the possibility of change (v11). Why is it harder to break from some sins than others?
6. Read Genesis 2:18. What makes you suitable as a spouse or friend? What can you do to increase your suitability?
