God's Will - God's Part

The Lord Jesus Christ gave himself for our sins to rescue us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father (Gal.3:4)

He chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accord with his pleasure and will (Eph.1:4-5)

This is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day. (Jn.6:39-40)

God's Will - My Part

It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honourable, and no one should do wrong or take advantage (1Thess.4:3-8)

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you (1Thess.5:16-18)

It is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people. (1Pet.2:13-15)

God's Will - Benefits

Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother (Mk3:35)

We ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will... so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power... so that you may have great endurance and patience, and giving joyful thanks to the Father (Col.1:9-12)

When you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised (Heb.10:36)

If we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us – whatever we ask – we know that we have what we asked of him (1 John 5:14-15)
