<sup>1</sup>Brothers, if someone is caught in a trespass, you who are spiritual should restore him with a spirit of gentleness. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted.

<sup>2</sup>Carry one another's burdens, and in this way, you will fulfill the law of Christ.

<sup>3</sup>If anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

<sup>4</sup>Each one should test his own work. Then he will have reason to boast in himself alone, and not in someone else.

<sup>5</sup>For each one should carry his own load.

<sup>6</sup>Nevertheless, the one who receives instruction in the word must share in all good things with his instructor.
