Thought starters for personal reflection or group discussion

1. Luke 22:12 shows that we benefit from what others have done, and others can benefit from what we do. What is an example you reaping what others have sown?

3. If our lives are not unfolding according to God's plans, can we say why His plans are going astray; and is there anything we can do about it?

5. What word recurs in Isaiah 43:7, Isaiah 60:1, and 1 Corinthians 10:31? How is it possible for everything we do to be a display of God's glory?
