3. Now read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. What themes in that Old Testament text (Ps.24) are repeated in this New Testament text? What new ideas are added in this 1 Cor. text?
4. When Satan claimed ownership of the world (Luke 4:5-7), Jesus did not argue with him about ownership. Why is that a helpful tactic for dealing with a lie? In Jesus' answer (v8) He addressed a different part of Satan's claim. Why did Jesus make this His focus?
5. Why is 1 John 4:4 true?
6. How does James 4:6-8 work?
7. The request of Luke 8:38 is a good idea. Why was it denied; and why was v39 a better idea?
