For personal reflection, or group discussion

- 1. What are some indications that our world today is not as christianised as it has been in the past?
- 2. Write 2 lists: advantages; and disadvantages, of an unchristianised world.
- 3. Why should we be glad to live in this unchristianised world?
- 4. It is often said that our 3 greatest enemies are this world, the flesh, and the Devil (based on Ephesians 2:2-3a). What are the opposites of these and how are they helpful to us?
- 5. Read Philippians 4:4-9. We are not to be anxious/worried (v6a). Name each of the factors that help us obey this command, and tell how each of them is helpful (v4-7). What are the factors in v8 and how do they help us live in an unchristianised world? What is the key action in v9 and why is it important?
- 6. "When you hear of wars and rumours of wars, do not be alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still future." (Mk 13:7) Jesus reassured us that wars and earthquakes are not signs of the end of the world. Do you find this comforting?
