Holy living happens in unholy v12-17

Holiness is not found in the v12-13

Romans 3:10-23 "All have sinned" Ephesians 2:1, Colossians 2:13

1 Samuel 2:2 "There is no one holy like the Lord" Rev.15:4, Mk.1:24

Holiness is hard to find in v15-17

1 Peter 3:15 "Honour Christ the Lord as holy"

Holy living happens through holy v19-21

Holiness requires I avoid v19

Jesus never mentions His (v16-17)

Holiness requires I focus on the v19-21

4. Explain the difference between: Positional, Progressive, and Permanent Holiness. Why are they each important?
5. Jesus was asked about His disciples, but He said nothing about them. Why was that; and what do we learn from that?
