3. Read Mark 10:40. On what basis might someone be granted the seats next to Jesus? How is it possible for ordinary believers to become more like these special two?
4. Read Mark 10:42-44. Why would Jesus warn His followers against becoming like the world in our organisation, attitude and practice?
5. Jesus repeatedly use the words: serve, service, served, servant. What are some reasons why Jesus Himself came as a servant? Why is it important for us to be servants? Review Point 3 of the sermon, and suggest practical applications for each "I serve..." statement.
