Intro: Naughty or Nice.

Facts: God everyone to be saved.

God has made for everyone to be saved.

Not everyone will make the choice

Samaritans worship the unknown... Salvation is via the Jews. John 4:22

It is by grace you are saved, through faith... Ephesians 2:8-9

Salvation is in one name else, there is no other name... Acts 4:12
