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My Prayer Points for this week

For personal reflection, or group discussion

1. When you see a sumo wrestler, do you think 'power'? What thoughts does that sight bring to mind? What sights do you find attractive?
2. Research shows that emotions as widely varied as anger, fear, disgust, love, gratitude, sympathy, happiness, and sadness can be conveyed by touch with a high degree of accuracy. How would you convey those emotions just by touch?
3. In what ways do you think touch may change past / present / future? Read 2 Corinthians 6:17. Why do you think God gives both: these instructions, and this promise?
4. Read Mark 10:14. What emotion did Jesus show? Are you easily angered? How comfortable are you when others are angry? How do you deal with anger?
5. Read John 8:31-32. What is the difference between having an idea, and having the truth? What can truth free you from? What can truth free you to? How does truth help you enter God's Kingdom?
6. Why are words so powerful? How can words be a curse or a blessing? Can words alone ever be a blessing? How can we increase the level of blessing conveyed by our words? What blessing will you say this week?
