### The myth of . . . . . . . . . succession

Myth: Church A is better than Church B, because Church A was established &/or led by an Apostle.

33AD. All the believers, except the apostles, were scattered. Acts 8:1,4

50AD. Antioch has prophets and teachers but no apostles. Acts 13:1-3

55AD. ...go to Jerusalem to see the apostles. Acts 15:2

Jerusalem church led by James, the Lord's brother. Acts 15:13-21
