Thought starters for personal reflection or group discussion

2. What is the value of the first word of this prayer?
3. Who is the focus of the opening requests, and who is the focus of the later requests? Why is that order important?
4. Suggest ways in which I can answer each of the five requests:
1. consecration, 2. Kingdom, 3. Bread, 4. Forgive, 5. Temptation?
5. Martin Luther said, "Temptation is the best school into which the Christian can enter; yet, in itself, apart from the grace of God, it is so doubly hazardous, that this prayer should be offered every day, 'Lead us not into temptation;' or if we must enter into it, 'Lord, deliver us from evil.'" What was he trying to teach us?
