## What if God escaped!

- <sup>3</sup> It is we who are the true circumcision; we who worship by the Spirit of God; who glory in Christ Jesus; and who put no confidence in the flesh.
- <sup>4</sup> However, If anyone could have that confidence, it is me. <sup>5</sup> I was circumcised when I was eight days old. I am a pure-blooded citizen of Israel and a member of the tribe of Benjamin; a Hebrew born of Hebrews. As far as keeping the Jewish Law is concerned, I was a Pharisee. <sup>6</sup> As for my zeal, I was a persecutor of the church. As far as righteousness in the Law is concerned, I was blameless.
- <sup>7</sup> But whatever was an asset to me, I now count as loss for the sake of Christ. 8 What is more, I consider everything as loss, because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. It is for His sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ 9 and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the Law, but that which comes through faith in Christ; the righteousness from God that depends on faith.
