### Thought starters for private reflection or group discussion

1. Have you ever imagined yourself actually being in the events described in the Bible?
2. What does Mary's song tell you about her (Luke 1:46-48)? Why did she need to be told Luke 2:35? In what ways do today's believers need to be like Mary?
3. What does Matthew 20:20-21 tell you about Mary's sister, Salome? Why did she need to hear v22? In what ways do today's believers need to be like Salome?
4. The other Mary is known only through her husband (Clopas) and sons (esp. Joseph). What lessons do today's believers need to learn with Mary?
5. Maggie (Mary Magdalene) had a slow start (Luke 8:2). She didn't always get it right (John 20:2). But she was rewarded (Jn.20:11-18). What lessons do today's believers need to learn from Mary M?
6. Jesus did not entrust the care of his mother to her own children by Joseph, nor to her sister, Salome, but to her nephew, John. Why was that the best choice? What lessons do today's believers need to learn from this arrangement?
