Thought starters for personal reflection or group discussion

1. Think of the different types of musical instruments in an orchestra. What does the brass section add that the other instruments cannot provide?
2. What do you think could be the significance of this Feast, a) not on the anniversary of some important event; b) being held on mid-year's day; and c) on the night which has the first glimpse of a waxing moon?
3. Throughout the Old Testament, trumpets were sounded to announce celebrations, but also to warn of impending danger. How can believers today balance the Good News of God's grace, together with His justice and judgement?
4. Most Old Testament feasts feature a lot of trumpet-blowing. Suggest a reason for all that noise.
5. When Jesus returns, and the trumpet sounds (1 Thess.4:16) we will be transformed. Why does Jesus return with the sound of the trumpet, rather than the lyre?
6. The coronation of a new king was announced with trumpets, eg. 1 Kings 1:39. Explain why Jesus' return is announced with trumpets.
